How to qualify to be married in Italy

The first thing to understand is the differences between a religious wedding, a blessing ceremony and a civil ceremony. Only if both of you are certified Catholics, you may be able to have a church blessing, also known as a mixed ceremony, but only a few priests are willing to do this. If neither of you is Catholic your options are a civil ceremony in the Town Hall or a ceremony in the city's Protestant church.
